Divyangjan Policy

Discrimination against individuals with physical and mental disabilities is prohibited under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016. The Right to Education emphasizes the need for inclusive education, ensuring that students with learning difficulties and impairments have their educational needs met. R.T.C. B.Ed. College is committed to preventing all forms of discrimination, including those based on disability. R.T.C. B.Ed. College follows an inclusive policy to make education accessible to all segments of society, including differently-abled individuals. The Divyangjan Policy outlines the institution's guidelines to maintain a disability-friendly campus and provide an environment free from discrimination.

Objectives of the Policy

- To create an inclusive campus culture that avoids all forms of discrimination and exploitation of disabled students.
- To make campus infrastructure accessible and friendly for differently-abled students.
- To ensure all campus facilities and programs are accessible and enjoyable for these students.
- To effectively implement all legal provisions applicable to differently-abled individuals on campus.
- To foster care, concern, and support from all college members, ensuring a disabled friendly environment.

The major initiatives to be taken as per the policy include:

- To address all disability-related issues in the institution.
- To ensure overall accessibility for the Divyangjan students and staff in the entire institution and its departments.
- To provide the essentially required resources, infrastructure facilities, guidance, and experts' suggestions.
- To determine major grievances on any matter of Divyangjan persons. If it is not resolved, it should be sent to the dignitaries.
- To provide counselling for Divyangjan students on the types of courses they can study in higher education.
- To adhere to the orders dealing with fee concessions, examination procedures, reservation policies, etc., referring to Divyangjan persons as per the government policies from time to time.
- To aware the faculties about the approaches to teaching, evaluation procedures, etc, which they should adopt in the case of Divyangjan students.



- To assess the educational needs of Divyangjan students.
- To provide support to Divyangjan students and assist them in getting appropriate employment after their studies.
- To generate appropriate remedial measures for Divyangjan students.

Accessibility Policy

Providing access means making all the institutional services, activities and the benefits thereof, fully available to qualified people with disabilities. The institution should provide various provisions in creating a Divyangjan friendly campus. The institutional administration and faculty members should ensure appropriate / reasonable accommodations for each person with a disability, and be willing to resolve access problems. The campus should be barrier free and accessible for persons with differently abled.

Accessibility of Resources

- All students and staff members must be accessible to all the infrastructural facilities available in the institution.
- Accessibility to text books and study material to all students with disabilities.
- To ensure all teaching and non-teaching members of the institution are aware of the facilities available and express the issues of accessibility.
- Exam cell ensures the smooth transition of examination resources to the students /staff /Person with Disabilities (PwD).
